

# THE CLEANUP BY THE NUMBERS

After 100 years of industrial use, there was a lot of work to be done to bring the Woodfibre site up to today's industrial standards. Here's a snapshot of the steps\* that have already been taken to improve the site and that allowed it to earn two official Certificates of Compliance from the BC Ministry of Environment.

\*work began in 2013 as a condition of Woodfibre LNG's purchase agreement and was completed prior to close of the sale.
